

It is our pleasure to bring Holy Communion to the sick and elderly of our Parish. Please notify the Office.

Baptisms: Parents who wish to have their children baptized should be registered at the parish at least three months prior to requesting baptism, after which they are asked to complete a baptism registration form. This may be picked up after any Sunday Mass. Once completed, it should be returned to the parish office. Parents and godparents will be requested to attend a Baptism Preparation Class held at Our Lady of the Lake Church.

Marriages: Couples planning to be married must contact the parish at least one year in advance. They must also receive personal preparation prior to entering marriage. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a wedding date until the Bishop's office has been contacted and necessary procedures are done.

FIRST COMMUNION INFORMATION FOR ALL PARENTS OF CHILDREN IN GRADE 2 THIS YEAR

All parents of children in Grade 2 who attend Catholic, Public, Private, or Home School, are required to register their children for First Communion by picking up a **First Communion Registration Form** after any Sunday Mass. The form must be completed and returned after any Sunday Mass by the deadline which is <u>Sunday, October 11</u>. All parents are also required to attend a **First Communion Parents' Meeting.** The date, place and time is forthcoming .It is important to note that if your child attends a **public school, private school, or is home schooled**, they are **required to attend weekly First Communion classes in the parish**. Classes will begin in October after Thanksgiving

CONFIRMATION INFORMATION For Parents of Children in Public School, Private School or Home School

If you are a parent of a child in Grade 8 who attends either a public or private school, or if your child is home schooled, your child will be required to attend weekly Confirmation Classes in the parish. It is imperative that you register your child in the program by picking up a **Confirmation Request Form** after any Sunday Mass from either Monsignor or parish office. The form must be completed and returned after any Sunday Mass by the registration deadline which is **Sunday, October 11th**. As soon as class dates are confirmed, they will be published in the bulletin.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> This does NOT apply if your child attends Our Lady of the Lake Catholic High School. More information regarding registration and requirements is forthcoming.
