Introduction

The focus of Mary's Assumption into heaven is not on her as one unique member of the human race. It is on the full fruition of the graces of Christ's Resurrection offered to the whole human race embodied in her. Mary stands for all of us.

Today's Readings

First Reading: Revelation 11:19a, 12:1-6a, 10

God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen within his temple.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:20-26

Orthodox icons of the Dormition of Mary tell of the belief that at her death Mary was taken up body and soul into heaven as a foretaste of the Resurrection. They express the hope that all human experience is destined for glory through the saving power of Jesus.

Gospel: Luke 1:39-56

As an unmarried woman, Mary had no status in Israel. As an unmarried mother, she risked public shame and death by stoning. She had nothing, yet she believed that God's power could make of her a blessing for all the world.
