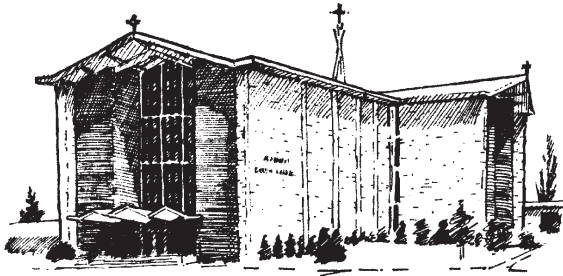

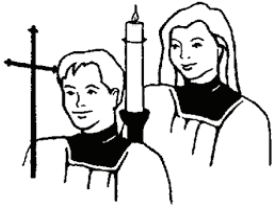
OUR PARISH
