

Sixth Sunday of Easter

"It has been decided by the Holy Spirit and by ourselves not to saddle you with any burden."

Introduction

Today's Readings convey a clear, if uncomfortable, message about the Church as the body of Christ. Since the beginning, people, have tried to impose rules and controls on who is an insider and who is an outsider, who belongs and who is excluded. Jesus' own teaching is very clear. It is the Holy Spirit who judges and guides not only the leader but all the faithful. Our attempts at exclusion and control are according to "the world", not the Spirit.

Today's Readings

First Reading: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

The leaders of the early Church allow themselves to be guided by the Holy Spirit in their decisions.

Second Reading: Apocalypse 21:21:10-14, 22-23

John's revelation is of the Church as the new Jerusalem, a walled and gated city, but these are not built to exclude sinners or those we consider unworthy of outsiders. The temple is the body of Christ himself.

Gospel: John 14:23-29

At the Last Supper, Jesus speaks words of inexpressible comfort. He promises that the Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Spirit, will find a home in us as individuals and as a community, when we learn to keep his word.
