ST. JOHN'S BIBLE

After Mass on Tuesday, March 14, there will be a presentation of the St. John's Bible in the parish centre. The St. John's Bible is a work of art and a work of theology, having been copied by hand with enlightening illuminations of various familiar stories found throughout scripture. A brief presentation will be made about the Saint John's Bible and it's production and then we will take a look at the Gospel of John, particularly the Gospel passages we will read this year on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent- the woman at the well, the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus. 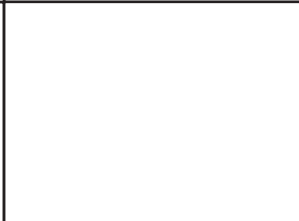
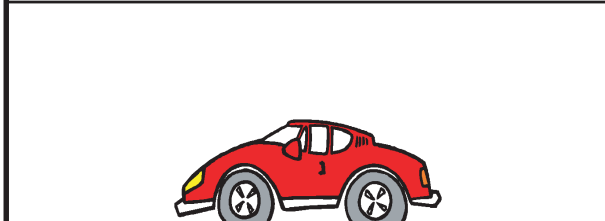
