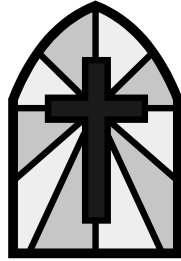

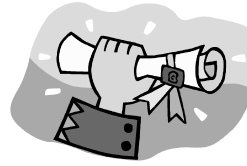

CHILDREN'S LITURGY ANNOUNCEMENT

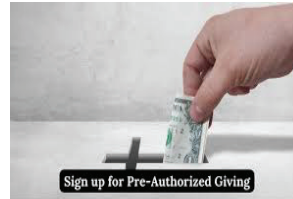
The last class for Children's liturgy will be June 23rd at 11:00 a.m. Mass. Details to follow to resume in September. Thank you for all your support!

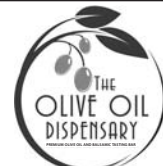
