EASTER TRIDUUM: Through His paschal mystery, the Lord Jesus redeemed the human race and gave perfect glory to the Father. By dying, Christ destroyed our death; by rising, he restored our life. Celebrating the suffering, death and resurrection of our Lord is the high point of the liturgical year. The Easter solemnity is to the year what Sunday is to the week. The celebration of the Easter Triduum opens with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, reaches its climax in the Easter vigil, and closes on Easter Sunday

<u>Paschal Fast:</u> The Church of God fasts on Good Friday and Holy Saturday to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare to share more deeply in the joy of his resurrection. Good Friday is a universal day of fasting and abstinence from meat.

The Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday evening is a very long liturgy. It includes the lighting of the fire, seven Scripture readings interspersed with responsorial psalms, blessing of the water, renewal of baptism promises, and the liturgy of the Eucharist. In other words, it is not an ordinary Saturday Vigil Mass and is definitely not for the faint of heart. If you are bringing children to an Easter mass, you may want to choose one of the masses on Easter Sunday rather than the Easter Vigil.


