From the Pastor's desk:

Gratitude

A great big "Thank You" to everyone who was involved in serving the Lord and their fellow parishioners over the Sacred Triduum. For fear of missing someone, I will not mention the respective ministries. You know who you are, so this is my personal message to each of you. There are always many people involved in doing things during the Holy Days and a parish does not function without them. God bless you and Happy Easter as we continue celebrating the resurrection of Jesus for the next fifty days.

Sacramental Preparation

During Holy Week many people who do not attend Mass on a regular basis appear on the scene. They read the bulletin and hear about First Communion and realize that they have a child that should have had First Communion a few years ago but because they don't have their child in catechism the child missed. Now they think that they can squeeze their child into receiving First Communion which is scheduled to happen in a couple of weeks. Well, I can assure those parents that this is not going to happen. Recently, a mother took the Sacred Host during communion time and then proceeded to break the Host in two in order to give half to her daughter who, obviously had not yet received her First Communion. This denotes a lack of understanding on what we as Catholics believe and practice regarding reception of the Holy Eucharist. The same is true for the many who do not genuflect when they enter and leave their pew. It saddens me greatly to see this lack of acknowledgement and respect for Jesus present in the Eucharist. However, all is not lost. I notice that a lot of "older" children coming with their parents at communion time and not receiving the Eucharist. So, I am wondering how many actually fit into this category? If there are sufficient, perhaps we can offer some preparation classes. If you have a child in this category, then speak to me, to Lynda McCorquodale or phone the church office. This will help us determine a more exact number.

Bishop Athanasius Schneider

At the end of May, Bishop Athanasius Schneider, who is the auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of St. Mary in Astana, Kazakhstan, will be in Winnipeg to receive the Regina Sacratissimi Rosarii Award. 
