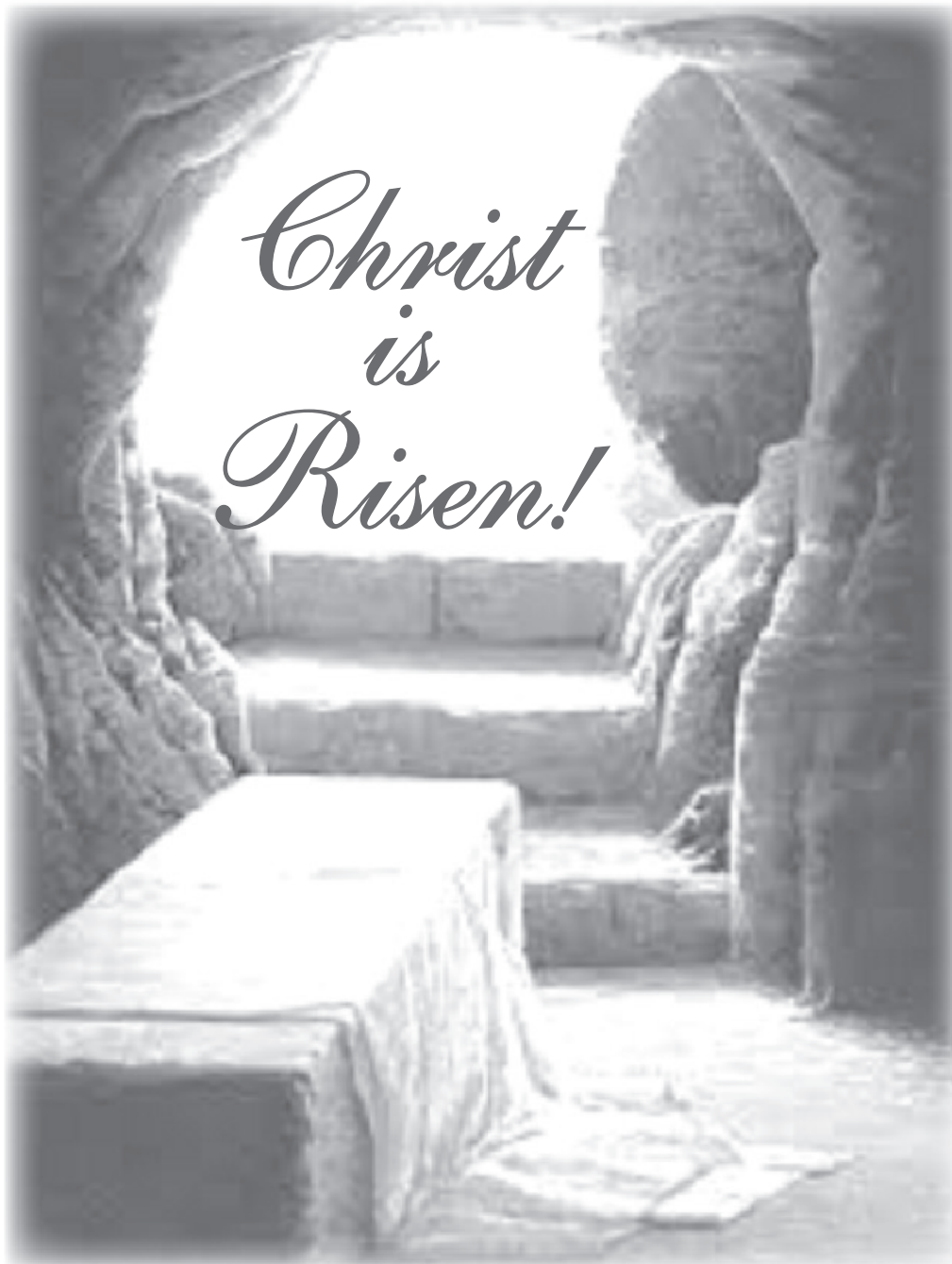

From the Pastor's desk

Jesus is risen! Happy Easter.

I am filled with joy as I prepare to celebrate the beautiful solemnity of Easter. To each of you and your loved ones I send my deepest wishes for a blessed Easter and Easter season as we celebrate God's unconditional love for each of us. Easter is the greatest and most important feast of the Church and it has been celebrated since the actual resurrection of Jesus two thousand years ago. We celebrate Easter for three reasons. The resurrection proves that Jesus is God. Our catechism tells us "The Resurrection of Jesus is the crowning truth of our Faith in Christ, a Faith believed and lived as the central truth by the first Christian community; handed on as fundamental by Tradition; established by the documents of the New Testament; and preached as an essential part of the Paschal mystery along with the cross..." CCC#638. Easter is also our guarantee of our own resurrection. As we heard in the Gospel a couple of weeks ago, on the 5th Sunday of Lent, Jesus assured Martha at the tomb of Lazarus "*I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me will live even though he dies.*" Jn. 11: 25-26. Jesus will raise up all faithful followers on the last day. Easter is a feast which gives us hope and encouragement in our present journey through life which is often marked with hardships. It is our belief in the Real Presence of the risen Lord in our souls, in the Church which Jesus left us, in the Blessed Sacrament and in heaven that gives meaning to our personal and communal prayers.
