
K of C dues envelopes are available at the back of the church. Anyone who pays their dues before December 31st will be entered into a draw to

Introduction To Penitential Rite: On Gaudete Sunday we rejoice that the Lord is near. As we gather at this Mass, we know he's very near indeed, especially in his Body given for us and in the Body of those who are gathered in worship. As we celebrate sacred signs in holy rituals, we call to mind how unworthy we are, especially if we lived this week without hope or the knowledge that God's providence is alive and active among us.

Isaiah 35:1-6a, 10 In the first reading, arid lands become lush gardens. Things come to life when people listen to the word of God.

James 5:7-10 In the second reading, we hear about the patience of farmers and prophets. Their example calls us to be patient as we wait for Christ's coming.

Matthew 11:2-11 In the Gospel, Jesus confirms his messianic identity. He also points to the prophetic greatness of John the Baptist.


