First Holy Communion & Confirmation

Naskamoonan Project, May 2-11, 2019

Are you looking for a Canada-based project in which you can put your talents to use, help others and learn about indigenous culture in a very direct way? Perhaps the Naskamoonan Project is for you. Naskamoonan means "We are grateful" in the Cree language. This expresses the privilege and the opportunity to meet and learn from the Cree community while also sharing our own cultural backgrounds. This project will take a small group of postsecondary women, aged 18-26 up to the Cree community of Moose Factory Isand where they will give relevant workshops to young mothers and to their female mentors. There will also be a meeting of the youth with the elders as they join in the local volunteer projects. Enrich your day working with the elders, visiting shut-ins and the sick, doing small projects for those who need the help. This is one of several endeavours offered by Opus Dei. Introduction To Penitential Rite: One of the most basic experiences we have in the presence of God's holiness is to recognize that we are sinners before God. To acknowledge that and to confess it is what God asks us to do. Not to confess it is arrogant on our part because we are basically saying I done need to confess that I am a sinner. As we prepare to celebrate this Eucharist, let us remember that God is happy to work with us as we are.

Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8 In the first reading, a prophet stands in the presence of God. He feels unworthy until he is purified by a servant of the heavenly court.

1 Corinthians 15:1:11 In the second reading Paul tells how he handed on the astounding Good News of Christ's resurrection. He stresses his own faith and his ministry to the grace of God.

Luke 5:1-11 In the Gospel, Jesus calls and commissions his disciples. He vividly demonstrates how they will be fishing for people


