All confirmation candidates are expected to attend a rally which will be held at Immaculate Conception Parish, 181 Austin Street here in Winnipeg on Saturday, 28 March 2020. The Archbishop will be present. Since he will be unable to attend Confirmation in the parishes this year, the rally will be an opportunity for him to meet the confirmation candidates. Confirmation candidates mark your calendars for that day.

A Few Reminders

Although I have mentioned these numerable times before, they still merit being repeated. First, if you are attending Mass at another parish, perhaps due to shift work or a conflict in schedules, please do not place St. Anthony of Padua Parish envelopes in their collection basket. When people do that they are forcing staff from that parish to mail your envelope to St. Anthony's, thus involving postage stamps, stationary, plus the work of finding our address and mailing it. Either, drop in a gift without an envelope or save your gift until you return to St. Anthony's. **Second**, please do not stand in the gathering area when there are empty spots within the body of the church. Also, do not take-up one of the benches in the gathering area or crying room unless you have small, unruly children. Third, do not leave Mass following reception of Holy Communion. The Mass is not over until the priest gives the blessing. Besides not totally fulfilling your Sunday obligation, leaving Mass early, without a valid reason, is simply rude. Four, no gum chewing or eating in church; and don't put your gum under the pew. Five, men remove their hats when they enter the church. It is irreverent not to do so. Six, genuflect to Jesus present in the Tabernacle, when you enter your pew and when you leave. Seven, those receiving Holy Communion on the hand should place the Sacred Host in their mouth immediately. Eight, during flu season we won't shake hands as a sign of peace, instead, a greeting with a nod or bow.


