Fast & Prav

Pope Francis has asked that the entire Church fast and pray for peace in those areas of the world where there is presently so much conflict, especially the Congo and South Sudan. He has declared that **Friday**, **February 23rd** be that particular day for fasting and praying for the aforementioned. Church law indicates that **fasting** applies to those **18 years** of age and remains binding until the beginning of their **60th year**. The law of **abstinence** is binding for everyone **14 years** of age and onward. We can each abstain from something: a food item, from television, from internet use, from various vices, etc. When we fast and pray, God most certainly hears our prayers. In other words, fasting and praying gets God's attention.

executive meeting will be held on Feb. 27 at 7:30pm and the General meeting on March 1st beginning with a prayer service in the hall at 7:00pm.




