Disaster Relief: Turkey & Syria

We have all been emotionally moved by the recent earth quake in Turkey & Syria which has claimed the lives of thousands of people. Ash Wednesday & Lent

This coming Wednesday, 22 February 2023, ushers us into the liturgical season of Lent. We are encouraged to do forms of penance, abstinence and fasting during the six weeks of Lent. Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fasting for those aged 18 to 59 and abstinence from meat for those aged 14 and older. We do these forms of penance in solidarity with those who have little or no food to eat everyday. We are also encouraged to pray more, especially to make the Stations of the Cross and walk with Jesus as He walked the route to Golgotha. May the Lord richly bless us as we fast, pray, spend more time with Jesus, attend Eucharist on weekdays as well as on Sunday, visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in the Adoration Chapel and do penance.
