Bravo & Thank You Parking Attendants

Due to four baptisms following Mass and an urgent call to Seven Oaks Hospital I was unable to attend the brunch, other than to offer the blessing. Ash Wednesday/Lent

This coming Wednesday, Feb. 26, we begin Lent. Lent has two major purposes: It recalls or prepares for Baptism and emphasizes a spirit of penance. Through forty days of closer attention to God's Word and of more fervent prayer, believers are prepared to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. The Church encourages penitential practices during Lent. Ash Wednesday is one of two days when the Church asks us to fast. The other day is Good Friday. Fasting binds all the baptized who are physically able to fast from the age of 18 to 59 years. Abstinence from meat binds all from the age of 14 and older. Christian fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, to share more in the suffering of those who are starving and to save money which is given to the poor. Fasting is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a means of purification and spiritual liberation, a witness of the depth of our faith.

Parents and educators are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. Baptisms here at St. Anthony during Lent are deferred until the Easter season. However, if there are extenuating circumstances, then we will baptize during Lent. The "alleluia" and the Gloria are both omitted during Lent. Flowers are not permitted in the church except on Laetare Sunday, Solemnities and Feasts. We are encouraged to pray the Way of the Cross during Lent and various groups here at St. Anthony's will lead the Stations on the Fridays of Lent. You are encouraged to attend the Way of the Cross as a form of penance.

Travelling Chalice

The present schedule for the travelling chalice and prayers for vocations to the priesthood and religious life is approaching the end. There is a new schedule available in the gathering area. If you wish to receive the travelling chalice into your home with the commitment to pray for vocations, then select a week and sign up.

Confirmation Rally

All confirmation candidates are expected to attend a rally which will be held at Immaculate Conception Parish, 181 Austin Street here in Winnipeg on Saturday, 28 March 2020. The Archbishop will be present. Since he will be unable to attend Confirmation in the parishes this year, the rally will be an opportunity for him to meet the confirmation candidates. Introduction To Penitential Rite: Today's Gospel passage calls for us to be perfect as our heavenly Father is perfect. We know that we cannot approach perfection without admitting our sins and accepting God's mercy.

Leviticus 19:1-2, 17-18 In the first reading, Moses challenges the people to model their own holiness after the holiness of God. They will do so if they put others first.

1 Corinthians 3:16-23 In the second reading, Paul reminds the community that they are God's temple. They are to be holy and mutually helpful, united to Jesus and his Father.

Matthew 5:38-48 In the Gospel, Jesus calls his followers to be whole and complete just as God is whole and complete. He gives concrete examples.

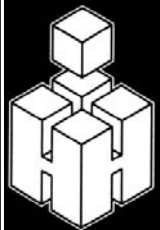
