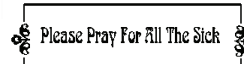
Parish Committees:

Stewardship Bulletin Reflection
February 4th – 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's first reading Job reminds us that life is short, "Remember that my life is a breath". From that perspective, our vocation as Disciples of Christ takes on a certain sense of urgency. For St. Paul, and Jesus, proclaiming the Gospel was an urgent priority in their lives. We see that in today's readings. Our life is short, and today, more than ever, there is an urgent need for each of us to be good stewards of the Gospel. Living as authentic Christian stewards inspires us to be agents of evangelization. Our faith is a gift from God. As stewards of the mysteries of God, we want to share the gifts and graces we have received from God. We desire to share Jesus with those who do not yet know him. St. Paul's words today are worthy of us remembering, "Woe to me if I do not proclaim the Gospel".
