Catholic Missions in Canada Awareness Day

CMIC was founded in 1908 and one of the founders was Archbishop of Winnipeg, Alfred Arthur Sinnott. Last year, CMIC provided \$260,000 in funding to mission communities in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg. The Archdioceses of St. Boniface and Winnipeg have designated Feb. 9, 2020 as our day of prayer for CMIC. There are prayer cards provided by the Archdiocese of Winnipeg which will be distributed at the Masses on that weekend. Thus, we can become more aware of the mission work done by CMIC and perhaps support them with our finances. There is no official collection for CMIC this year, however we may consider this as a special goal for our parish Lenten almsgiving.




