Who can be married?

Any adult Catholic, who is free of a prior bond of marriage, may freely enter into marriage with another adult Catholic or someone of another Christian church or religious tradition. In marriage, a man and a woman are joined in an intimate bond of love and life.

Who can be married in this parish?

Anyone who fits the first criteria and must be attending and registered with our parish for at least 1 year before any arrangements can be made for a wedding.

Couples who live in another community, province or country and who wish to be married at St. Anthony's must first contact their own parish priest, who will be responsible for all necessary documentation and preparations for marriage; only then, upon the recommendation of the parish priest, can a date be arranged with St. Anthony's Parish. 1 Corinthians 1:1-3 In the second reading, Paul begins a letter to the Christians in Corinth. He reminds them of his apostolic calling and wishes them grace and peace.

John 1:29-34 In the Gospel, John the Baptist fulfills his role as witness by proclaiming Jesus to be the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.
