Catholic Women's League take action.

The CWL have two petitions addressed to the House of Commons on the long table in the entrance of the church. Bill S-210 is a bill which would protect young people from pornography on the internet. Bill C-7 is a petition asking the House of Commons to revoke the expansion of Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID) to the mentally ill. I commend the CWL for their stand and action on both of these petitions and I encourage everyone to support and sign both petitions.

Canada's Plummeting Population.
