The Sacrament of Confirmation

The very basis in being a Catholic is to engage the privilege of attending Mass each weekend.

'One of the great theologians': Winnipeg Catholics mourn Benedict

"Winnipeg's Catholic community is mourning the death of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI. Benedict died on Dec. 31 at the age of 95. He was the first Pope to retire from the job in 600 years, ceding the position to Pope Francis in 2013. But his contributions to the church go way beyond his short time at the top, according to Richard Gagnon, Archbishop of Winnipeg. "He was Pope for eight years, but he was an important member of the Vatican curia, heading the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith for many years before that," said Gagnon."
