### Sacramental "quick fix"

Last March 31, April 7, April 14 and April 21 I placed a piece in our parish bulletin regarding parents who inquire about their children who have not been in catechism and have not received the sacraments of baptism, first communion and confirmation or any combination of these three. Of course, parents who fit into this category do not attend Mass and do not read the bulletin, so they are not aware of what I wrote. Since then we have had several inquiries about catechism, baptism, first communion and confirmation. Unfortunately, we do not have people who are willing to teach and spend time with these children on a one-to-one basis. If anyone is willing to teach some of these children on an individual basis, please let me know. This fall we will not be accepting individuals who fall into this category; not because we don't want to, rather because we do not have the personnel to accommodate them. It is important to keep children enrolled in catechism and not just to present them at the time of First Communion or Confirmation. Father Dominic

### **11<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Introduction:** Not much has changed from last week, but a lot has changed from 100 years ago. The kingdom is like the growth of a mustard seed, and if that's true, we can barely see its change if we're judging it on our experience of seven days of God's grace. Let us bring our lack of hope and any discouragement before the Lord so that he can bring light to your blindness and hope to our futures.

**Ezekiel 17:22-24** In the first reading, God promises to restore the kingdom after years of exile. The people will at last have a kind devoted to God.

**2 Corinthians 5:6-10** In the second reading, Paul speaks of living up to the gospel with courage. In this way, he can be confident when he appears before the judgment seat of Christ.

**Mark 4:26-34** In the Gospel, Jesus compares the kingdom of God to tiny seeds which mysteriously grown into ripened grain.
