## From the Pastor's desk

### Ordination to the Priesthood of Chris Pugh

I am very pleased to announce the ordination of Chris Pugh to the priesthood on Friday, 28 June 2024 at 7 pm in St. Mary's Cathedral. Chris was born and raised in Brandon. All are invited to the ordination celebration. It will probably be awhile until we have another ordination, so I encourage you to attend. Chris' first Mass will be in Brandon at St. Augustine of Canterbury Parish on Saturday, 29 June 2024 at 4 pm. I will be giving the homily at Chris' First Mass, so Fr. Collin Peterson will be offering the Vigil Mass here at St. Anthony's in my absence. I will be back for the two Masses here on Sunday morning. Please pray for Chris Pugh as he approaches ordination.

### Sacramental "quick fix"

Last March 31, April 7, April 14 and April 21 I placed a piece in our parish bulletin regarding parents who inquire about their children who have not been in catechism and have not received the sacraments of baptism, first communion and confirmation or any combination of these three. Of course, parents who fit into this category do not attend Mass and do not read the bulletin, so they are not aware of what I wrote. Since then we have had several inquiries about catechism, baptism, first communion and confirmation. Unfortunately, we do not have people who are willing to teach and spend time with these children on a one-to-one basis. If anyone is willing to teach some of these children on an individual basis, please let me know. This fall we will not be accepting individuals who fall into this category; not because we don't want to, rather because we do not have the personnel to accommodate them. It is important to keep children enrolled in catechism and not just to present them at the time of First Communion or Confirmation. Father Dominic
