As such, parents are to give their babies a new name to reflect their new Christian nature. The apostles, martyrs, evangelists and saints become our "heroes", not Hollywood soap stars or sports favourites. If you are uncertain of what is and what is not a Christian name, we here at the office can help you. At least one of the names should be Christian if their first name is not a Christian name.

Introduction To Penitential Rite: God gifts each of us uniquely, as God gifted John the Baptist with a role and mission in building the kingdom of God. We acknowledge now our gratitude for the mission God has given each of us, and we ask pardon for the times we have failed to be faithful to that mission.

Isaiah 49:1-6 In the first reading, loyal servant expresses his devotion to God. For his service he will become a light to the nations.

Acts 13:22-26 In the second reading, Paul describes the role of John the Baptist. John is to prepare the people for the coming of Jesus.

Luke 1:57-66, 80 In the Gospel, Elizabeth and Zechariah miraculously become the parents of John the Baptist. He is officially incorporated into Judaism through circumcision and naming.

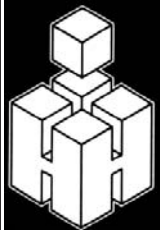

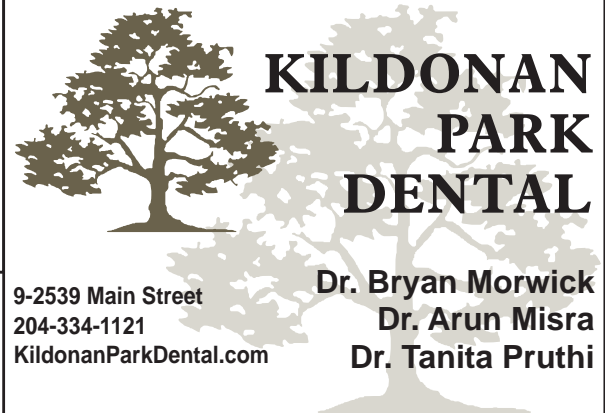
