The majority of our parishioners have returned to regular Sunday Mass attendance. Archbishop Gagnon has discontinued the dispensation to not attend Mass, which he gave during the pandemic several months ago. It is our privilege to attend Sunday Mass each and every Sunday. The 3rd commandment is: *"Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy"* Exodus 20: 8. Sunday Mass attendance is also one of the precepts of the Church. "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass." #2180 Catechism of the Catholic Church. Attending a weekday Mass instead of attending on Sunday, the Day of the Lord, does not fulfill the Sunday obligation.

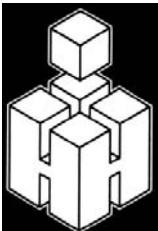
