Daughters of Mercy

The daughters of mercy are a group of women who consecrate themselves to the Lord Jesus. Their mission is to pray for the priests and the Archbishop, as well as to intercede for more vocations to the priesthood. Their daily duties of prayer and sacrifice include: prayer for priests written by St. Theresa of Lisieux, a Holy Hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament, Holy Communion at least once a week, rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, Angelus, Memorare, Divine Office at least once a day, examination of conscience, frequent confession, and once a month the daughters of mercy get together as a group to pray one of the daily offices and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for vocations to the priesthood here in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg. Father Peter Nemcek is their chaplain. There is no financial cost. Should you be interested in becoming a Daughter of Mercy please speak with Fr. Dominic who will give you the particulars.

Stewardship Bulletin Reflection **Sunday June 3rd – Body and Blood of Christ**

What an incredible gift we are given in the Eucharist! The word 'Eucharist' has its origin in the Greek word *eucharistia*, which is a translation of the Hebrew word *berekah*. All three words mean thanksgiving or gratitude. With grateful hearts Sunday after Sunday each of us bring different kinds of gifts to the Mass. *"What do Christians bring to the Eucharistic celebration and join there with Jesus' offering?"* The answer... ***"Their lives as Christian Disciples; their personal vocations and the stewardship they have exercised regarding them; their individual contributions to the great work of restoring all things in Christ"*** (1992 USCCB Pastoral Letter – Stewardship, A Disciple's Response). And then, we are sent! Sent out to be good stewards of what we have just received. St. Augustine said, *"We hear 'Body of Christ' and we say 'Amen!' Be a member of the Body of Christ so that your 'Amen' may be the truth."* May your gratitude to God for the gift of Christ's Body and Blood in the Holy Eucharist inspire you, so that, your life is a reflection of your 'Amen'.



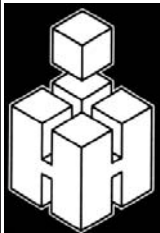
