

<u>2 Corinthians 13:11-13</u> In the second reading, Paul encourages the Corinthians to live in peace. He prays they will enjoy the gifts that come from the Trinity.

<u>John 3:16-18</u> In the Gospel, Jesus proclaims that God loved the world so much that God gave for its salvation the gift of God's only Son.
