St. Anthony of Padua Festivities

The patron of our parish, St. Anthony of Padua's Feast Day is Monday, 13 June. We will celebrate his Feast beginning this coming Saturday with a Novena at the end of Mass. The novena will be prayed each day at the end of Mass for nine days, ending on Sunday, 12 June. There will be veneration of his relic at the end of the 4 pm Mass on Saturday, 11 June. We will then have a procession around the block with his relic and a statue of St. Anthony of Padua. Snacks will follow in the parish hall. On Sunday, 12 June we have the fund raiser meal for the people of Ukraine following the 11 am Mass. On Monday, 13 June, following the 9 am Mass we will have veneration of his relic. Let's celebrate our patron saint and his devotion to Jesus Christ.

Pentecost

Introduction To Penitential Rite: On this great Solemnity of Pentecost, we call to mind not only our sinfulness, but our goodness as well. We are all created in God's own good image. We pray that we may live in the spirit of Pentecost, aware of the Holy Spirit's indwelling within us.

Acts 2:1-11 In the first reading, the apostles begin preaching the Good News. The Holy Spirit makes the message clear to all the nations.


1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13 In the second reading, Paul reminds us that the Spirit lives in us. The Spirit's power enables us to experience the Father of Jesus as our Father.

John 20:19-23 In the Gospel, Jesus appears to his frightened followers after his resurrection. He grants them his peace and commissions them through the gift of the Holy Spirit to carry on the work he began on earth.

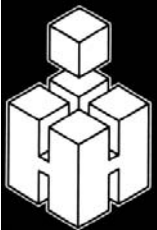
