Introduction To Penitential Rite: In today's Gospel, we hear about three temptations offered to Jesus. Because we know that we have not always resisted the temptations offered to us, we now recall God's mercy and forgiveness.

Genesis 2:7-9, 16-18, 25; 3:1-7 In the first reading, God gives god gifts to the first man and woman. But when they give in to temptation they learn its consequences.

Romans 5:12-19 In the second reading, Paul tells us that sin entered the world through Adam's disobedience. It has led all humans to sin and death. Christ's obedience has brought justification and life.

Matthew 4:1-11 In the Gospel, Jesus refuses to succumb to the devil's temptations. He reaffirms his obedience and commitment to the word of God.


