From the Pastor's desk:

Archdiocesan Synod Implementation

The Archdiocesan Synod Implementation Commission has begun its work in bringing together the proposals and applications from our Synod process. One of the themes which was expressed by the Synod was that of being Missionary Disciples in our modern world, that is being agents in the New Evangelization. The Archbishop has asked that each deanery and each parish consider ways of implementing the initiative, namely that all the baptized acquire a familiarity with Sacred Scripture. To that end we are to incorporate more Scripture reading and study during our parish and deanery meetings, also in Bible study (which we already are doing) and in the home. A good time to begin is during Lent, but we should continue to make Scripture reading an integral part of our lives. I have posted the Archbishop's letter on the bulletin board for all to read.

Synod Implementation Global Initiative #3: "We encourage all the baptized to acquire familiarity with Sacred Scripture"

This Lent, as part of the implementation of our Archdiocesan Synod, we are invited to connect with family and friends in a very special way using *Lectio Divina* or "Breaking open the Word". This ancient method of praying with sacred texts dates to the fourth century. The four simple steps of *Lectio Divina*: reading, meditation, prayer and contemplation take about 20 minutes.

Lectio Made Simple for Families

- Settle in a cozy spot
- Read the Sunday Gospel, slowly, 2 or even 3 times. (encourage children to use their imagination – can you see yourself in the story?)
- One of the following questions can be discussed after each reading of the scripture passage (allow everyone an opportunity to speak.)
- Encourage a response. "What did you like in the story?"
- God speaks to us through this story. "What do you think God is saying?" Listen deeply
- "What might God be asking you to do?"
- Close with the Our Father. Share a healthy treat.

Conference on Young People

Last October there was a Synod on young people held in Rome that focused on their faith and vocational discernment. Discussions centered around ways in which young people might serve God and make our world a better place. Summarizations of this synod are contained in a papal document entitled Apostolic Exhortation and can be read on the Archdiocesan website. There will be a special day of presentations here in Winnipeg on Saturday, 30 March 2019. The location will be St. John XIII Parish, located at 3390 Portage Ave. and the cost for attendance will be \$30. Speakers are Bishop Lionel Gendron, bishop of Saint Jean Longueuil, Quebec and Emilie Callan, who was a synod youth auditor from Toronto. This conference is open to anyone of interest. 
