MARRIAGE: Contact the parish office 6 months or more before marriage. Marriage Preparation is mandatory in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg.

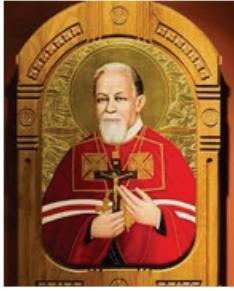

Knights of Columbus Aid to the Ukraine

The KOC have committed \$1 million of immediate aid to the Ukrainians impacted by the Russian invasion. The KOC have also launched the Ukraine Solidarity Fund, pledging to match all funds raised up to an additional \$500,000. So far, the fund has raised more than \$2.4 million, for a total of nearly \$4 million in assistance. The Knights in Poland are also delivering much-needed aid to those in Ukraine, and to those seeking refuge in Poland. The Knights have also established a housing network for refugees, along with "mercy huts" along the Ukrainian/Polish border to welcome refugees. Meanwhile, the KOC in Ukraine have coordinated the distribution of supplies through the "Anti-Crisis Committee", a group established by the Archdiocese of Lviv. One positive reaction to the crisis caused by Russia is the great good that has emerged from many hearts, as well as the solidarity of the KOC in their assistance. If you would like to contribute to the efforts of the Knights of Columbus in providing assistance to the Ukrainian refugees, you may do so through St. Anthony of Padua Parish. Mark your cheque: Aid to Ukraine. The parish will forward your gift to the Knights of Columbus to assist in their noble efforts to assist the refugees.

When to baptize:

I quite often write reminders about baptism because I continue to receive requests for baptism for children that are a year or older. Some parents are honest enough with me to admit that they just want to have the baptism on the child's first birthday in order to do two parties at once. I tell parents that a one-year old child is not likely to remember his/her first birthday. **We do not wait one year before baptism.** Jesus was presented in the temple 40 days after his birth; not 365 days later. Our catechism states: "Parents are obliged to see that their infants are baptized within the first few weeks. As soon as possible after the birth, indeed even before it, they are to approach the parish priest to ask for the sacrament for their child, and to be themselves duly prepared for it." Chances are that those needing to read this won't, for one reason or another. So, if you are aware of a relative or friend who is in this category, do them and us a favour and inform them of the above.

Bingo No More

For many years bingo has been a Wednesday evening hall activity. The pandemic brought an end to many activities, including bingo. It has been two years now since the last bingo was played here at St. Anthony's. The directives from the Archdiocese instruct us that if the bingo stops, we are not to revive it. After consultation with the parish trustees, Ken Chrzanowski who has organized the bingo, the two CWL members who worked the canteen, as well as the chancery office, it was agreed that it is now time to bring an end to bingo here at St. Anthony's Parish. We may very well be the last parish within the Archdiocese of Winnipeg that supported bingo. We thank Ken Chrzanowski, Anna Sanduliak, Anna Anderlic, as well as all the volunteers over the years for their dedication to Wednesday evening bingo. The proceeds raised have assisted in many projects both within and outside the parish, including the sanctuary renovations and snow removal. We are grateful to the Knights of Columbus members for assisting in various ways with the bingo. In order to empty the pot, we are required to have one final game. That game will be held on Wednesday, 30 March 2022. So, come one, come all for the last bingo at St. Anthony's! Get the word out to all the bingo lovers.

Rev. Fr. Paolo Manna (16 January 1872 – 15 September 1952) was an Italian Roman Catholic priest and a member from the Pontifical Institute of Foreign Missions as well as the founder of the Pontifical Missionary Union of Priests and Religious. He was passionate in promoting the missions, evangelic and Apostolic life.

He was Beatified by Pope John Paul II in 2001.

3rd Sunday in Lent

Introduction To Penitential Rite: As we gather today on this third Sunday in Lent, let us ask God's forgiveness for the times we have been impatient and intolerant with ourselves and others.

Exodus 3:1-8a, 13-15 In the first reading, God appears to Moses as he leads sheep through the desert. He will soon shepherd his people out of Egypt.

1 Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12 In the second reading, Paul recalls that many of the Israelites failed to respond to God's gifts. This is a warning to Christians to appreciate and respond to Christ's saving acts.

Luke 13:1-9 In the Gospel, Jesus proclaims that, while God is patient and enduring, God is also just and repentance is necessary for all.

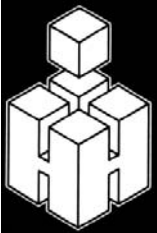
