Good Friday-fasting & abstinence

A reminder that Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. Fasting for all those 18 years of age and up to the end of their 59th year. Abstinence for those aged 14 years and upward. It goes without saying, that a medical condition would exempt a person from the aforementioned.

Attire for Ministers of Holy Communion

After a delay, the present government will revisit and probably find a loophole to implement a law to allow those with a mental illness to terminate their lives. Conservative candidate for prime minister, Pierre Poilievre stated that he would entirely revoke the expansion of medical assistance in dying for the mentally ill, if he becomes the next prime minister. This, in itself, should help rational voters at the polls when the time
