From the Pastor's desk:

Ash Wednesday

This year Lent and Easter are on the late side. Lent prepares us for Easter as we recall our baptism and do penance in preparation for the greatest Feast of the year. For forty days we look closer at the Word of God and pray more fervently as we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. Ash Wednesday is this coming Wednesday. As is our custom, there will be two Masses that day, one at 9 am and the other at 7 pm with the distribution of ashes. Keep in mind that **Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence.** Those between the ages of 18 to the end of their 59th year are obligated to fast from food. Those aged 14 and older are obliged to abstain from meat. We are all encouraged to do some form of penance and mortification during Lent. Shut off the electronics and use that time to pray and read the Scripture, abstain from alcohol, from sweets, from coffee, etc. Do something in addition to your normal routine, like: pray the stations of the cross daily, visit the sick/shut-ins, give food to the Sisters of Mother Teresa who minister to the poor, give alms, double your normal Sunday collection, etc. Here's wishing you a productive Lent and a joy-filled Easter.

Enrich Your Marriage

I invited a couple, Miriam and Stan Amalades from the World Wide Marriage Encounter to arrange an experiential 2.5 hour presentation here at St. Anthony of Padua Parish in preparation for the WWME which will take place this coming fall. The 2.5 hour presentation will take place on Saturday, March 23, 2019 from 1-3:30 pm in St. Anthony's church hall. This event is for any married couple who would like to enhance their marriage and for any couple who may be struggling with their marriage. It is also for priests, so the priests from the Winnipeg North Deanery are also invited. There is no charge for this event. Of all institutions, marriage and the family are under attack in our society and in the world. As Catholics, and like most Christians, we believe that marriage has been ordained by God between one woman and one man. The WWME is a non-profit organization and promotes the premise of marriage between one woman and one man. 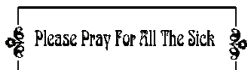

8th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Introduction: Today's readings urge us to draw life from hearts filled with the goodness and teachings of the Lord ... to live virtuous lives that bear sound fruit. This week, we may desire to pray for a discerning heart and spirit, committed to trying to find God's invitation and his will in the actions and fruits of our daily life.

Sirach 27:4-7 In the first reading, the author uses images from everyday experience to highlight the importance of our words, suggesting that our moral worth (or the lack of it) can be proved by our speech.

1 Corinthians 15:54-58 In the second reading, Paul encourages the Christians in Corinth to see Christ's resurrection as the source of their hope. He also exhorts his hearers to persevere in doing good and working for the Lord.

Luke 6:39-45 In the Gospel, Jesus also uses simple reflections on human experience in his teachings. Disciples must learn from their master, and in the process become like him. Having warned against the danger of judging others, he also states that just as a tree's value is judged by its fruit, so the true test of human virtue is the way we live our life.

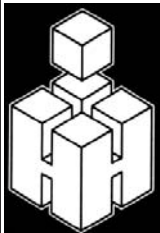
