March 4th – Third Sunday of Lent

Secularism is removing the Ten Commandments from public places and policy. Secularists are ignoring that "God spoke all these words". (Exodus 20:1) I like to look at the Ten Commandments through the lens of stewardship. For example, the Fourth Commandment - Keep the Sabbath Holy. Every day is a gift from God and something that we can always be grateful for. Gratitude inspires us to be good stewards of each day. In total, there are 168 hours in a week. Attending Mass every Sunday is a great way for us to give one of those hours back to God, in thanksgiving. And, we can do even better than that! Let's reclaim the whole Sabbath. The next Executive meeting will be Thursday, March 15 at 7:00pm and the next General Meeting will be on Thursday March 22, at 7:00pm.




