MARRIAGE: Contact the parish office 6 months or more before marriage. Marriage Preparation is mandatory in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg.

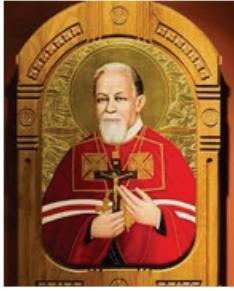

On May 3, 2022, the *Pontifical Mission Society for the Propagation of the Faith* (POPF) will celebrate two major milestones. It will mark the 200th anniversary of its foundation as the *Association of the Propagation of the Faith* and the 100th Anniversary of its *Pontifical* status, conferred by Pope Pius XI in his Motu Proprio *Romanorum Pontificum*, thus confirming the missionary spirit of the Society and its important service to the universal Church. By the same Motu Proprio, the Holy Father also conferred *Pontifical status* to the Society of the Holy Childhood and the Society of St. Peter the Apostle. The foundress, Pauline Marie Jaricot will be beatified on May 22, 2022, in Lyon, France

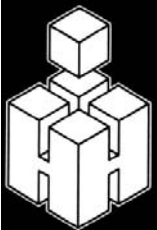
