Our Lady of the Cape Statue

We are privileged to be able to have the statue of Our Lady of the Cape with us on **Thursday & Friday**, **5 & 6 May**. The statue is from the shrine located at Trois-Rivieres, Quebec. The shrine is the second largest in North America and is located on the site of a church which was built in 1720 by Father Paul Vachon. The statue was donated by a man on his way to the gold fields in hope of protection in 1854. The statue depicts Mary as she is said to have appeared to Catherine Laboure in Paris in 1830. On June 22, 1888 the statue opened its eyes for about 5-10 minutes. Shortly after reports of cures began to be announced. In 1904, Pope Pius X authorized a canonical coronation for the statue. You are invited to come and spend some time in the presence of the statue and pray for the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
