Donations of Coffee, tea and sugar packets would be greatly appreciated. These items are used for Funerals, workshops, religious teachings and meetings.

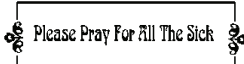

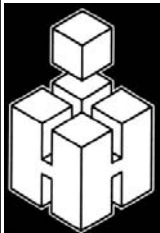
