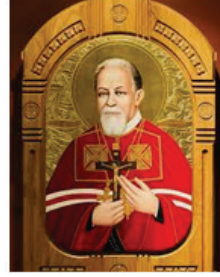
### May – Month of the Holy Rosary

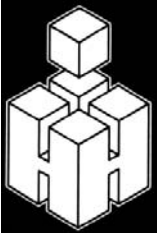
