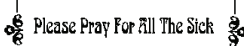
THANK YOU! to everyone who brought in plastic bags, rosaries, and all the other items from the list that we were collection for various organizations and recycle programs! It was a huge success!!

Introduction To Penitential Rite: As we prepare to celebrate these sacred mysteries, we remember that we are called together as a Church today. Our sins against unity are not always obvious, but when we choose ourselves over others, we are not allowing the gospel to work its power over evil and self-concern

Acts 15:1-2, 22-29 In the first reading, differences threaten to divide the Church. But the Holy Spirit leads the way to unity and peace.

Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23 In the second reading, we see the new Jerusalem gleaming with the splendor of God. It is the fulfillment of God's plan for all Israel and for the Church of Jesus

John 14:23-29 In the Gospel, Jesus promises his disciples that God will send them an Advocate, the Holy Spirit. The Spirit will teach them and remind them of all that Jesus has said.

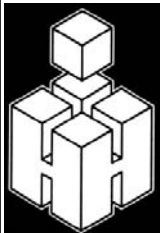
