### Confirmation 2023

This year the Sacrament of Confirmation was conferred on Tuesday, 16 May. The Archbishop, the catechism coordinators and myself were very pleased with the preparation involved prior to the actual sacrament. Archbishop Gagnon is always very considerate in thanking those involved in both the sacramental preparation as well as the liturgy. Nonetheless, I would also like to thank everyone involved in helping the 27 confirmandi prepare for the sacrament and in assisting with the liturgy. The teachers were: Claude Valcourt, Jake Dava and Cita Musni. The class did a great job in answering the Archbishop's questions. Thank you to the coordinators Rosa and Catherine for all their work in preparing for the liturgy as well as Conrad, Zeny and Marco for providing the music on Confirmation evening. Thank you also to our parish secretary Colleen for all her office assistance regarding catechism throughout the year. God bless all of you. We pray that the confirmandi will remain faithful to Christ and involved in their parish for their entire lives.

### Catechism Registration

We continually receive requests from individuals who are lapsed in their faith or who are "shopping around" to find a parish that will receive their child/children into our catechism program. Frequently, people do not register or attend Mass until their children are in Grade 2 or Grade 8; in other words the sacramental years. Others present their children at various levels, and we are supposed to do a "quick fix" on them. Children who are older need a one-to-one catechism teaching experience. Any volunteers? This is just another reminder that we only accept children of registered, contributing parishioners. People must be registered for a minimum of one year. Sorry, but we don't have any magic wands!

### Music

We are blest to have musicians in our parish. Many parishes do not have any. However, we are always looking for more people who can sing or play organ or keyboard. If you can help, please approach any of those involved in music ministry or myself and we will help you get started. Thank you to those presently involved in music ministry. What would we do without you!

### May, the month of Our Lady

This beautiful month of May is dedicated to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary. I encourage you and ask that every family/household together will recite the holy Rosary, especially during the month of May. Every morning during the week, we begin with the rosary at 08:30 am. We would like to encourage people to come to Mass early enough to pray the rosary. Especially now when the sun rises so early. Join us in recitation of the rosary.

### Ordination to the Priesthood

Deacon Oliver will be ordained to the priesthood on Friday, 9th June 2023 at 7:30 pm in St. Mary's Cathedral. All parishioners and others are welcome to attend this happy event. Oliver's First Mass will take place here at St. Anthony of Padua Parish at 4 pm June 10. A supper will follow in the parish hall. Limited Tickets (\$25 per person).
