This trip follows the Holy Father's critical meetings with First Nations, Métis, and Inuit Elders, Knowledge Keepers, survivors of residential schools and youth in Rome. 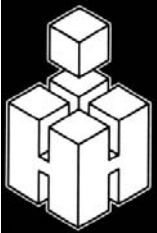
