Continued Suspension of Public Liturgies

On April 20, 2020, the Government of Manitoba announced that the provincial COVID-19 State of Emergency will be in place until May 18, 2020. Following this announcement, and in consultation with the Catholic bishops of Manitoba, as well as the Deans of the Archdiocese, Archbishop Gagnon has determined that public liturgies in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg will continue to be suspended to May 18, 2020.

The Fruits of Adversity

For the past two years, our Archdiocesan family has been focused on how to continue to grow in faith and service. During the recent Archdiocesan Synod, delegates voiced their Spirit-informed recommendations that were later grouped into three overarching categories: forming the baptized as missionary disciples; passing on the faith to the next generation and others; and reaching out to those in need and on the peripheries. Then, just as individual parishes were planning their own Listening Sessions, that would generate community initiatives, the world was hit with the coronavirus. The pandemic seemed to cause all our efforts to come to a grinding halt as non-critical services and public gatherings needed to be restricted. 

Introduction To Penitential Rite: On this Good Shepherd Sunday, we pause to reflect on and repent of whatever sinfulness has separated us from God and from one another. We seek the grace to make amends to those whom we offended.

Acts 2:14a, 36b-41 In the first reading, people respond to the preaching of the apostle Peter. They want to know what they must do to be saved.

1 Peter 2:20b-25 In the second reading, Peter reminds us of Christ's sufferings. Thus he became our model and source of saving grace.

John 10:1-10 In the Gospel, Jesus proclaims that he is the true gate through which the sheep enter and thus will be saved.

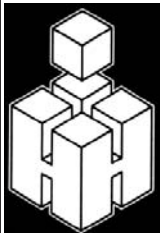
