Introduction To Penitential Rite: Today's Gospel looks forward to the moment of judgment each of us must someday face. As we begin this celebration, we pause for a moment to acknowledge our faults, trusting in the magnitude of our God's mercy.

Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17 In the first reading, a prophet has words of comfort for a people in exile. God will gather them together and lead them home.

1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28 In the second reading, Paul tells us that Christ's resurrection was his victory over death and evil. Eventually he will hand over his kingdom to his Father.

Matthew 25:31-46 In the Gospel, Jesus teaches that at the final judgment those who are not Jews or Christians will still be able to enter the kingdom of God. It depends on whether they have done acts of mercy to Christian missionaries.
