From the Pastor's desk:

Election-federal & provincial

As Canadians we have the right to actively participate in the election of our government. Voters should question candidates on their political, social, ethical and economic positions. (Canadian Bishop's Pastoral Letter, 2006). We need to be informed about the critical issues that are at stake in the elections, seriously look at the moral issues and vote to build the "culture of life", thus being faithful to God's law. The Church proclaims the truths of God to which laws must conform; one of which is to be pro-life, from conception to natural death. When we vote, we do not cease to be Christians. So, how can we use our vote to advance pro-life initiatives?

Baptisms and Weddings

If you are planning to get married, please refer to our website for the details. A reminder that 6 months of active membership at St. Anthony's is a requirement as marriage is a vocation of the Church.

If you are planning a baptism you must first call the office and fill out the appropriate form. If you are not a registered member, there is a 3 month waiting period. Baptisms normally take place on the 3rd Sunday of the month. Depending upon the circumstances you may need to speak to the pastor.

Baptism Names

For parents having their babies baptized, please keep in mind what baptism is. The sacrament of baptism is sometimes referred to as a "Christening", that is, becoming a Christian. As such, parents are to give their babies a new name to reflect their new Christian nature. The apostles, martyrs, evangelists and saints become our "heroes", not Hollywood soap stars or sports favourites. If you are uncertain of what is and what is not a Christian name, we here at the office can help you. At least one of the names should be Christian if their first name is not a Christian name.

Marriage Preparation

The next marriage preparation sessions will be on October 18/19, 2019. If couples intending to marry wish to be a part of either of these sessions, please notify the parish office.

Baptism Preparation

The next baptism preparation sessions will be on October 5, 2019. Please register at the parish office well in advance.

Membership Registration

If you regularly attend St. Anthony's please register as a member. Parish membership helps us build parish identity and family. Forms can be found in the gathering space or at the parish office.

Bible study: Our next bible study will take place from January 6, 2020 to February 10. Monday evenings beginning at 6:30pm. This study will be "The Bible and The Virgin Mary". *The Bible and the Virgin Mary* unveils the mystery of Our Lady that is woven into the fabric of Sacred Scripture. 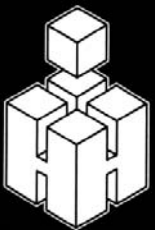
