Introduction To Penitential Rite: Jesus tells us a story in today's Gospel reading that challenges us to open our hearts to accept God's way of thinking and valuing. Let us repent of our need to do and see things our way and ask for the grace to be open to God's way of acting and loving.

Isaiah 55:6-9 In the first reading, a prophet explains how different God's ways are from the ways of the world. God is always ready to forgive.

Philippians 1:20-24, 27 In the second reading, Paul expresses his conviction that Christ is his life on earth. He also looks forward to being with Christ in eternity.

Matthew 20:1-16 In the Gospel, Jesus illustrates the saying that the last will be first and the first will be last. He tells the parable of day laborers hired at various times of the day to work in a vineyard.
