#### From the Administrator's Desk...

One of the questions that I often get asked when a person is facing a difficult situation is "Where is God in all of this?" Why does God allow bad things to happen to good people? Can't He do something to alleviate the suffering I'm facing? Can't He take away all my difficulties, and let me have a life of peace?

I remember posing these questions to our Campus Minister when I was in College, and his answer to me was that I should read and reflect on the Book of Job. In that book, we see Job, who is beset by suffering, asking many of the same questions of God, while his "friends" are trying to tell him that he must have done something wrong to provoke God's wrath. When God finally does speak, he does not answer Job's questions, but instead questions Job himself. We hear a portion of this questioning in today's First Reading.

In today's Gospel, we see the disciples facing a similar situation. As their boat is rocked by waves, Jesus is seen to be sound asleep in the back of the boat. When his disciples wake him in fear and in panic, Jesus calms the storm, and then proceeds to ask "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" It is these questions that help us to understand the deeper meaning of today's readings.

This Gospel is about more than Jesus having power over the wind and the sea. Above all, it is an invitation to trust in God, even when we find ourselves in the midst of the storms of life. Jesus has this level of trust in the Father, which is why he was able to remain sound asleep, even when the boat was rocked by waves. He knew that God was with him, even in that moment. We are called to place our trust in God, and to recognize that He is always with us- even though it may not feel like it at times. We are called to trust that God is bigger than our struggles, and that in the end, He will win the final victory over sin and death.

I leave you with an inscription written in a cellar where a number of Jews hid themselves during the Second World War. It reads simply: "I believe in the sun, even when it is not shining. I believe in love, even when feeling it not. I believe in God, even when he is silent." May we too keep our faith in God strong, and trust that God is always present with us, even if we cannot hear his voice speaking to us.
