From the Administrator's Desk...

This weekend, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. In both our First Reading and our Gospel, we hear how Jesus, forty days after he was raised from the dead, was lifted up into Heaven. This event is the culmination of the Paschal Mystery, through which the Resurrected Christ is glorified, and seated at the right hand of God.

When it comes to the important Solemnities in the life of the Church, such as the Ascension, It is important for us to ask ourselves what lesson this Solemnity is meant to teach us. From our readings it is clear that Jesus gives us a mission, and calls us to participate in the work of spreading the Good News. We refer to this command of Jesus as "The Great Commission." This commission forms the basis of Bishop Fabbro's call to us to be "a mission-oriented Church that forms disciples of Jesus."

When we consider the events of the Ascension, we might wonder why Jesus had to leave. Why couldn't he have stayed on earth, and continued to be physically present in the Church? If we search the Scriptures, we find in John's Gospel that the Ascension of Jesus is directly connected to the giving of the Holy Spirit. Jesus speaks of this extensively in John's Gospel. He reminds his disciples that when he returns to the Father, the Advocate (meaning the Holy Spirit) will come to guide us to the truth. It is this Spirit that enables us to complete the mission that Jesus has entrusted to us.

There is great power in a community which is united around a common mission: especially when that community is motivated and inspired by the Grace of the Holy Spirit. And that, I think, is our greatest challenge as followers of Christ: to remember that our faith is not only about our personal relationship with Jesus. That personal relationship, expressed in our prayer life, is an important aspect of the way we live our faith. But it is not the only aspect! We are also called to become more fully members of the community of believers, so that we may build up the Body of Christ on Earth, and more fully unite all the members of the body to Christ, our Head and Saviour. This work can only be accomplished in community- and so we pray for the grace to live that communal life as believers, which is a foretaste of the Kingdom of Heaven.

As we prepare to celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost next weekend, We pray for the renewal of the Grace of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.
