MAY 5TH—SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER 5 MAGGIO—SESTA DOMENICA DI PASQUA

From the Administrator's Desk...

This weekend's Gospel is a continuation of the passage we read last weekend, and it continues to stress the importance of abiding in God's love. It is also a reminder to us of what we are called to do with the love that we receive when we abide in God.

In John 13:34, Jesus tells his disciples that he is giving them a new commandment. This commandment is repeated in today's Gospel: "Love one another as I have loved you." Jesus further clarifies what he means by this commandment when he says: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." This type of love is the fullest expression of love that a person can give: It sets aside all ego and pride, and truly wills the good of the other person. It is a love that does not seek its own interests, but rather truly desires to give all for the sake of the other. In short, this is the love that Jesus showed us when his arms were outstretched on the cross.

In our second reading today, St. John reminds us that "In this is love, not that we loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins." This statement is remarkably similar to one made by St. Paul in Romans 5, when he states that "God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us." Both of these passages challenge us to re-think our understanding of the way we relate to God's love. Both of these passages remind us that God's love is already present in our lives. Our task is not to earn that love, but rather to respond to the love that has already been poured into our hearts.

When we truly begin to understand this, it can change everything about how we live. Instead of seeking forgiveness for our sins out of fear of punishment, we begin to seek reconciliations as a means of abiding more deeply in God's love. Instead of callously judging others, we begin to see how God calls us to be beacons of his love to the world. If we could all learn to live this way, imagine how different the world would be!

This week, I invite you to spend some time in reflection, and ask yourself if there is anything in your life that is currently keeping you from experiencing God's love present in your life. May we all pray for the grace to more deeply experience God's love, and know that we are loved, so that in turn we may fulfill the Lord's command to love others as he has loved us.
