

From a Parishioner:

I am really happy that we did not wait until our marriage was falling apart before we decided to get help. I even wish Retrouvaille was part of the marriage preparation course because, oh boy, it sure would have come in handy on some of our no holds barred shouting matches: you know, the ones you never could have imagined when you first got married, the ones where you bring up every little thing your spouse ever did wrong and wonder why they don't ever listen to you anymore (perhaps because you keep bringing up all of their flaws)?

We knew that we still loved each other, but often it was easier to each do our own thing rather than try to talk, especially about the big things like how to raise the kids. We were living the married single life: we were always together, especially during lockdown, but each doing our own thing, not enjoying being together. We had tried couples counseling in the past but it never worked because we both acted like defendants in a courtroom trying to prove our argument, always ready to counter-argue any criticism our spouse would throw our way. That was a recipe for disaster for us! I finally convinced my husband to try Retrouvaille after a particularly bad argument, when we noticed the negative effects of our constant bickering on our children.

I went into the Retrouvaille weekend convinced that my husband would finally realize how he had been neglecting my feelings and that he was the one who had the most work to do if our marriage was going to improve. Wow was I wrong!! What I learned was that we both needed to learn to communicate and to truly try to understand our spouse. I realized all the ways my husband showed his love and how I didn't notice it because I was too hung up on a certain demonstration of love. I am finally getting to understand why certain things are so important to him and even why some things he does are misinterpreted by me because of my own past. We are learning together that our feelings are valid. We are learning how to understand each other on a deeper level. And best of all, we don't have to share anything with a stranger like we had to in couple counseling. You only share with your spouse and that creates a deeper, more meaningful connection. Our marriage may not have needed saving as we were not at the point of separation; however, we definitely have a much better marriage now than ever. I would highly recommend Retrouvaille to any couple who feels a loss of connection with their spouse.


