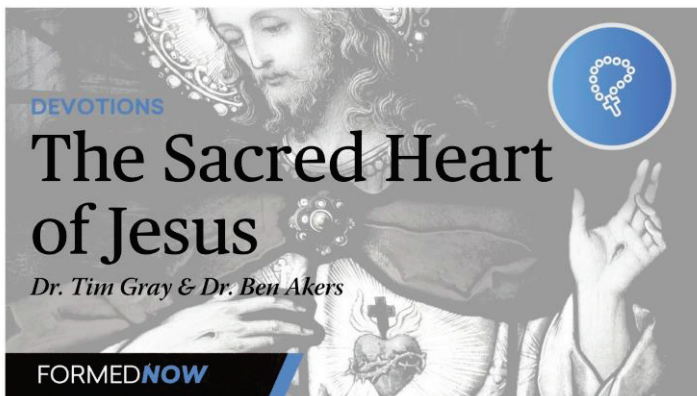
Shifra Homes Baby Bottle Campaign
