#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Pope Francis sent a video message on the occasion of the International Congress "Mujer exceptional", or Exceptional Woman, dedicated to the 50th Anniversary of the proclamation of St. Teresa of Ávila as a Doctor of the Church. Pope Francis spoke of how prayer made this great Saint an "exceptional woman". He said that St. Teresa was outstanding in many ways. However, he underlined, "it should not be forgotten that her recognized relevance in these dimensions is nothing more than the consequence of what was important to her: her encounter with the Lord, her 'determined determination,' as she says, to persevere in her union with Him through prayer, her firm intention to carry out the mission entrusted to her by the Lord, to whom she offered herself with simplicity." St. Teresa's boldness, creativity and excellence as a reformer, said Pope Francis, "are the fruit of the interior presence of the Lord." Let us continue to ask our patroness, St. Teresa, to pray for us and our intentions.
